Unsafe acts are performed when employees fail to abide by safety rules and protocols. These actions include fighting, horseplay, or performing a job without the necessary personal protective equipment. Unsafe acts are extremely dangerous and contribute to numerous incidents.

## SOME ASPECTS TO CONSIDER

Unsafe acts are **IRRESPONSIBLE** and will eventually lead to **INCIDENTS AND ACCIDENTS** in the workplace.



### IMPORTANT

be aware of these risks and take precautions to avoid **UNSAFE ACTS**

It's so important to be aware of the unsafe acts that can lead to incident. and to make sure you're always working safely.



**MOST ACCIDENTS** are caused when **UNSAFE ACTS** X **UNSAFE CONDITIONS**

Some examples of **UNSAFE ACTS** that can lead to incident:



Not paying attention



Taking shortcuts/  
rushing working activities



Using equipment improperly



Horseplaying
