SITE SAFETY SIGNAGE

Safety on site is not negotiable. Every site we work on follows strict safety requirements to protect workers, visitors, and the community. The following rules apply to all personnel and visitors entering the site.



1. What PPE must you wear at all times on site?
2. Who is allowed to enter the site?
3. What should you do if you see or are involved in an accident?

SITE ACCESS AND RESTRICTIONS



NO UNAUTHORISED ENTRY

Only authorised personnel are allowed on site



CHILDREN PROHIBITED

from entering or playing on the site



NO SMOKING

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

The following PPE is mandatory at all times:



SAFETY GLASSES



SAFETY HELMETS



PROTECTIVE FOOTWEAR



HIGH VISIBILITY JACKETS

HAZARDS AND WARNINGS



**OVERHEAD WORK
IN PROGRESS**

Remain alert for falling objects



DEEP EXCAVATIONS

keep clear of edges and do not enter without authorisation



**MOVING VEHICLES
AND TRUCKS**

Stop, look, and listen.
Always use designated walkways

GENERAL SAFETY PRACTICES



STAY ALERT AND AWARE

Site conditions and hazards change as work progresses



REPORT TO THE SITE OFFICE

All visitors and drivers must report to the site office on arrival



REPORT ALL ACCIDENTS

Immediately to the site office or your supervisor
